
WITNESS STATEMENT OF DR WILLIAM DOLMAN

I, WILLIAM FREDERICK GERRIT DOLMAN, of Hornsey Coroner's Court, Myddleton Road, London N8 7PY, state as follows:

1. I am the Defendant in these proceedings. I qualified as a medical practitioner in 1965. I have been HM Coroner for the Northern District of Greater London since 1993. Before that I had been Assistant Deputy Coroner for South London since 1974, Deputy Coroner for the same district since 1986, and Deputy Coroner for Inner West London since 1989.
2. I have been shown the Summary Grounds for Resistance intended to be filed in these proceedings. I confirm the truth of all the factual statements relating to me contained in that document, and I believe that the other factual statements made (which are based on information which I or my staff have obtained in the course of this inquiry) are true.
3. The Claimant has exhibited most of the correspondence passing between us (or between herself or her solicitors and my staff) prior to the issue of proceedings in this matter. But there are a few items which have not been included. For the sake of completeness I exhibit true copies of these

together as pages 1 to 8 of Exhibit "WFGD 1". As the copy of the Inquisition in Exhibit "SS 1" (page 1) is also rather faint, I also exhibit a better copy as page 9 of "WFGD 1". Finally, although the Claimant has exhibited a large number of photographs, they are only in black and white. To assist the Court I have therefore also included as pages 10 to 12 of "WFGD 1" colour copies of the nine photographs which were supplied to me by the Claimant and I actually admitted in evidence, so that the Court has the best possible record of those which were before me.

4. I believe that the facts stated in this witness statement are true.
